AGREEMENT TO PARTICIPATE
AUGUST 2020 – JULY 2021
Truman State University

You are invited to participate in the 2021 MOLSAMP Scholars program at Truman State University! This program is for students who are majoring in Science or Mathematics. Participants are expected to make satisfactory progress toward their degree and engage in program-related activities (described below). In exchange, participants will receive intrusive advising, study-skills workshops, tutoring support, community building and professional development activities.

To accept this invitation to become a 2021 MOLSAMP Scholar, you must read this agreement form and pledge to meet the program's expectations. By extending this invitation to you, the STEP Office pledges to provide you with support and encouragement that will help you succeed in science and mathematics at Truman.

EXPECTATIONS

I understand that by accepting the invitation to participate as a MOLSAMP Scholar, I will be expected to:

- Declare and make satisfactory progress toward a degree in science or math,
- Meet with the STEP Office Academic Advisor at the discretion of the Advisor, (most often weekly or bi-weekly),
- Accept academic support from the STEP Office Academic Advisor and academic trainers that the program will provide,
- Pass all of my science and mathematics courses with a C or higher,
- Maintain a GPA of 2.5 or above during the fall and spring semesters,
- Attend and participate fully in periodic meetings for the MOLSAMP program participants (at minimum, three meetings will be held each semester: a study-skills workshop, a professional development activity, and a community-building activity). Additional meetings may be scheduled.
- Complete the STEM 105 Inquiry Seminar in the Fall of my sophomore or junior year,
- And apply to summer research opportunities starting my sophomore year.

I understand that the MOLSAMP program aims to help its Scholars succeed in their pursuit of science and mathematics experiences (including coursework), and that it is the Scholars' responsibility to take ownership of their education and be proactive in their pursuit of academic and professional success in all areas of study.

I further understand that, as a MOLSAMP Scholar who is meeting the above expectations and making good progress toward graduating from Truman, I will receive the following from the STEP Office:

- Academic Advising from the STEP Office Academic Advisor,
- Supplementary advising from the STEP Office staff,

- Free individual and group tutoring for major-level science or mathematics courses arranged through the STEP Office in coordination with the Center for Academic Excellence,
- Career Planning and Awareness advice from STEP Office staff,
- An integrative introduction to science and mathematics through our STEM 105 Inquiry Seminar course,
- Opportunities to participate in MOLSAMP programming throughout the state (including research, conferences, and bridge programs), and
- Access to a statewide community of MOLSAMP scholars, faculty and staff.

Satisfactory progress toward a degree in science or mathematics during 2020-2021, full and active participation in MOLSAMP Scholar events, and an endorsement from the Truman science or mathematics faculty will make you eligible for continued participation in the MOLSAMP program in subsequent semesters.

*All selected scholars participate in MOLSAMP activities during the academic year for which they are selected. If a scholar enrolls in coursework or participates in a MOLSAMP-funded opportunity (example: research) during the summer, the scholar will be expected to remain in contact with the office during the summer semester as well.
